CODE OF CONDUCT

All Individuals who are a part of Jersey Sport's Performance Sport Programme must agree to and abide by the Code of Conduct as outlined below:

As a responsible Individual, I will:

- Conduct myself in a manner appropriate to represent my sport and island.
- Abide by my sport's relevant policies and procedures, including safeguarding.
- Actively engage in the Performance Sport Programme and use any associated funding and/or services solely for the intended purposes of supporting the development of my development as an Official.
- Consistently promote sport and my involvement in the Performance Sport Programme positively, whether that be in person, online, print, in the media or any other public or private promotion.
- Contribute to community engagement activities and services as requested and required by Jersey Sport, including contributing to at least one upskilling workshop.
- Anticipate and be responsible for my own needs and actions, acting ethically, professionally and with integrity.
- Never condone rule violations or the use of prohibited substances.
- Comply with all WADA, UKAD and GoJ Anti-Doping rules, regulations and procedures.
- Consent to share data with relevant organisations for the purposes of anti-doping compliance.
- Be responsible for my own personal medical insurance.
- Agree to inform Jersey Sport immediately, both verbally and in writing, of any changes to my personal circumstance that might affect my sport participation and/or status to be eligible as a Performance Sport Programme Official.
- Consent for Jersey Sport to use my image and images I provide to promote the Performance Sport Programme and other relevant funding streams or programmes.

This list should not be considered to be comprehensive or exclude other actions or behaviours that may be expected as minimum standards of any official.
